# POETIC COMMITMENT TO THE CLIMATE

The core fundamentals of Theatre Fragiles work is a commitment to creating strong emotional content through poetic mask theatre on current topics that move and inspire people. Since its formation in 2007, the companies interdisciplinary artistic productions have continuously been at the forefront and is known as one of Germany's most outstanding and innovative theatre ensembles performing in public spaces. In the new piece "ARE YOU READY?", the artists are tackling climate change and its consequences directly and to make the experience sensuous and perceptible for the audience. This TheatreFragile show is performed and sung in public space with 6 actresses, 70 cardboard blocks, masks and a choir all involved in the action.

## **ANCHORING IN SOCIETY**

TheatreFragile believes in the sharing of knowledge and the power of individual voices in their productions. In this project, TheatreFragile will collect local stories and insights that are told and interwoven into the performance to give personal insights into the current conditions. For this purpose, the artists go in search of these stories and conduct interviews with the local **people** asking and listening to their solutions, questions, opinions, ideas, options and views of changing climate. This research work is the starting point for the performance development with word and song. Excerpts from these interviews are audible sound collages of solutions and approaches. Terms and sentences from the interviews form the libretto of the songs. By involving the choir and inviting the audience to sing along, TheatreFragile in "ARE YOU READY?" seeks to create a sense of togetherness.

# CHANGEABILITY AS A SYMBOL

The stage design consists of recycled cardboard elements. These are animated and often played with in a variety of ways representing, a **symbol for changeability and adaptability**. The masks are made of cardboard, paper and fabric, instead of figurative masks, the actresses themselves are making them during the performance on stage in this piece. They illustrate the disorientation, the excessive demands and the fragility that climate change puts on us. **This scenario is so elementary that new narrative forms have to be designed for it.**
